

### **Employ-Ease Student Enrolment Privacy Notice**

I give permission for information to be shared between my Employment Service Provider (ESP) and Employ-Ease Pty Ltd and for Employ-Ease Pty Ltd to provide information to my ESP about my participation in this training course. Employ-Ease Pty Ltd does not disclose personal information it holds about an individual for the purpose of direct marketing, or to any overseas recipients. Employ-Ease Pty Ltd may disclose information held on individuals for valid purposes to a range of entities including:

- Australian Government Agencies including but not limited to Centrelink

In accordance with section 11 of the Student Identifiers Act 2014, Employ-Ease Pty Ltd declare that we will securely destroy personal information which we collect from individuals solely for the purpose of applying for a USI on their behalf as soon as practicable after we have made the application or the information is no longer needed for that purpose, unless we are required by or under any law to retain it. In providing your personal information as requested and signing this notice, you are confirming your receipt of, and understanding of these details, and providing your consent for the collection, storage, use and disclosure of your personal information as outlined.

The Department of State Development collects required information from this form for use by the Commonwealth Department of Education and the Department of Employment for the purpose of auditing participation and the monitoring and reporting of training outcomes. The information you provide may be accessed by officers of these three departments, by the National Centre for Vocational Education Research (NCVER) and Employ-Ease Pty Ltd for the above purposes. I have been advised by Employ-Ease Pty Ltd that I may be contacted and requested to participate in a National Vocational Education Research surveyor a Department endorsed project or audit review. ## Why we collect your personal information

As a registered training organisation (RTO), we collect your personal information so we can process and manage your enrolment in a vocational education and training (VET) course with us.

# How we use your personal information

We use your personal information to enable us to deliver VET courses to you, and otherwise, as needed, to comply with our obligations as an RTO.

# How we disclose your personal information

We are required by law (under the *National Vocational Education and Training Regulator Act 2011* (Cth) (NVETR Act)) to disclose the personal information we collect about you to the National VET Data Collection kept by the National Centre for Vocational Education Research Ltd (NCVER). The NCVER is responsible for collecting, managing, analysing and communicating research and statistics about the Australian VET sector. We are also authorised by law (under the NVETR Act) to disclose your personal information to the relevant state or territory training authority.

# How the NCVER and other bodies handle your personal information

The NCVER will collect, hold, use and disclose your personal information in accordance with the law, including the *Privacy Act* 1988 (Cth) (Privacy Act) and the NVETR Act. Your personal information may be used and disclosed by NCVER for purposes that include populating authenticated VET transcripts; administration of VET; facilitation of statistics and research relating to education, including surveys and data linkage; and understanding the VET market.

The NCVER is authorised to disclose information to the Australian Government Department of Education, Skills and Employment (DESE), Commonwealth authorities, State and Territory authorities (other than registered training organisations) that deal with matters relating to VET and VET regulators for the purposes of those bodies, including to enable:

- Administration of VET, including program administration, regulation, monitoring and evaluation
- Facilitation of statistics and research relating to education, including surveys and data linkage
- Understanding how the VET market operates, for policy, workforce planning and consumer information

The NCVER may also disclose personal information to persons engaged by NCVER to conduct research on NCVER's behalf. The NCVER does not intend to disclose your personal information to any overseas recipients
